



## Application Checklist

- Review Producer Guidelines & Responsibilities included in this packet.
- Provide a copy of your driver license or photo ID.
- Provide a copy of one utility bill with address matching driver license or photo ID.
- Complete and submit CAIP Program Certification of Identity and Request for Release of FSA Records. (white 1 page form included in this packet.)
- A copy of Kentucky Ag Water Quality Act Plan or Self-Certification Form
- If a tenant farmer, provide documentation listed on page 2 of application.
- Review changes in percent of investment matched of chosen investment areas located within the investment area guidelines. Guidelines of investment areas available upon request and online at <https://adair.ca.uky.edu/anr>
- Turn application in no later than August 21<sup>st</sup> at the Adair County Soil Conservation District located at 965 Campbellsville Road in Columbia, KY.

Thank you for your interest in CAIP (County Agricultural Investment Program) administered by the Adair County Cattlemen's Association. This program is being funded through the Kentucky Agricultural Development Fund.

At the end of the application period (August 21<sup>st</sup>) the applications will be reviewed and scored by a Scoring Committee which will consist of non-applicants and non-members of the County Agricultural Development Board. The scoring will be based on the scoring criteria as set forth by the Kentucky Ag. Development Board. You will be notified by a letter, indicating your approval or non-approval of your application.

The cost-share level of funding for Adair County applicants is: 50% cost-share with a maximum of \$2,500 per farm operation. Reimbursement will be distributed to funded applicants upon completion of the project. Farm must be located in Adair County.

### **DATES TO REMEMBER:**

- Eligible cost-share expenses for reimbursement will be **retroactive to January 17, 2024.**
- Deadline for **completion of project is January 17, 2025.**
